First Session was by Mr. Vijaya Kumar Ivaturi on Innovation for Digital India – A start up view. Mr. Ivaturi focused on few of the below points.

Tuning Mind Set of the Founder:

- Startups Focused on India as a Market
- Startups Focused on Global Market
- Hiring Problem: People who have wisdom but not the skill set, Startup need to hire mixture both people who have knowledge but lack a particular skill set (eg: a Particular computer language)
- Mr. Ivaturi is also an author of the book "Startup Manual for India"
- Focus on Founders agreement from the very start
- Project Management, Product Pricing Management
- Focus on Field view both sociologically & Technically.













Second Session was by Mr. Amitabh Shrivastava on - Insights from the Venture Capital World — Focus on The IAN Fund

- Mr. Amitabh explained the participant an investors point of view to fund a startup
- Investors Invest in Team "So focus on building a good Team". If any one team member is weaker the investor will rethink on investing.
- Investors identify if the company will be able to raise the next round of funding.
- Size of market and competition
- Assets of the company (IP, Patents) and commercialization of the same.
- Thought of Investing Terms & Exit Policy, is investor going to get ROI.

The Mentor Mixer provided a base for entrepreneurs to have peer to peer conversations and to interact with experts.
